



The estuaries, beaches, reefs and coastal waters are protected as part of the Great Barrier Reef and Great Barrier Reef Coast marine parks. Marine Park zoning and other regulations apply within the marine parks.

Warning: Estuarine crocodiles inhabit the sea, rivers and estuaries.

They may also occur on beaches. Attacks may cause injury or death. Do not swim in estuaries or rivers in the park.



Dangerous stinging jellyfish ('stingers') may be present in tidal and coastal waters at any time, but occur more frequently in the warmer months. A full body Lycra suit provides protection against stinging jellyfish and sunburn.
